What is a Geographer?

# Geography:

Derived from the Greek word which literally means “to write about the earth.”

“The bridge between the human and the physical sciences”

Or

“The mother of all sciences.”

# So, A Geographer is:

Someone who studies the earth and its land, features and inhabitants.

Typically, Geographers:

- Collect data through observations, maps, photographs, satellite imagery and censuses.
- Use surveys, interviews and focus groups for research.
- Create and modify maps, graphs and diagrams.
- Write reports and present research findings.

The complete river is a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) and a Special Area of Conservation (SAC)

The Wensum was named from an Old English adjective 'wendsum' meaning winding.
