Dear families,

As part of our commitment to delivering a genuinely rich curriculum, we work with Norwich-based circus company Lost in Translation to deliver an 11-week programme of circus performance skills for all children in Year 4, 5 and 6. Year 5 will go first with their sessions taking place on Wednesday afternoons. To launch this programme, the children will visit the home of Lost in Translation - the Oak Circus Centre on Coslany Street - for a tour, Q&A with the tutors, skills demonstrations and practical sessions. This will take place on Wednesday 18th September. The plan for the day will be as follows:

- 10.30: children depart from Wensum Junior School on foot
- 11.00: children arrive at OCC
- 11.15 - 12.00: tour of the centre, demonstration from LiT tutors, Q&A
- 12.00 - 12.30: lunch
- 12.30 - 2.30: workshops
- 2.30: depart OCC
- 3.00: arrive back at Wensum Junior School for collection as normal at the end of the day.

Additional information for families

Cost: This event is free to children as the circus skills programme is fully funded by the school.

Lunch arrangements: Many of our children are eligible for free school meals (FSM). This means that when we go on trips, we automatically provide a lunch for the child. Experience tells us that most children bring a packed lunch *regardless* of whether they are FSM. This leads to a lot of food waste. If your child is eligible for FSM and you want the school to provide a lunch, then please complete the box below and return to the school office by **Monday 16th September**. Thanks for helping us to reduce unnecessary food waste.

Clothing: The children will need to wear loose and comfortable PE clothing appropriate for a day doing physical activities. It can also be cold at the venue so the clothing needs to be warm as well. As we are walking there and back, please ensure that your child has clothing suitable for the weather.
